Recording Basics with Nik Kozub

This class is designed for newcomers to home recording and budding engineers. If you have a home studio or ever wanted to have a home studio, then this clinic is a must. There will also be a focus on setting-up your home studio, including room treatment.



Nik Kozub is actively involved in the recording, production and promotion of independent music in Edmonton. He has been a gigging musician in the Edmonton area since 1990, and has been involved in recording since 1997. He graduated from Edmonton's Grant MacEwan College music program in 1998 with a major in Recording Arts, and was recognized for his work with an award from CARAS (Canadian Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences). In 2009 he received the PACE Mayor's Award. He has toured extensively as a musician and live sound engineer throughout Canada, the US, England, and New Zealand. He has worked as a Recording Arts instructor at Grant MacEwan College since 2001, teaching their Arts Outreach Recording class. Nik is a member of the Juno-nominated band Shout Out Out Out Out, and has released solo material under The Paronomasiac moniker. Nik is also an accomplished remixer, having recently completed remixes for artists such as Moby and Hawksley Workman. Nik's studio work has been covered in EQ Magazine and Keyboard Magazine.
