You will be playing current and classic hits from many rock styles and bands.

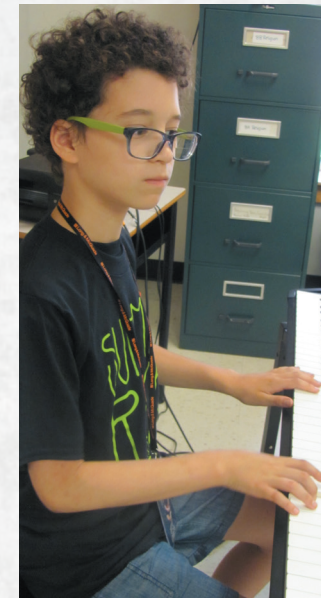
